The Dance Centre COVID Safety Protocols

★ Entering the building:

- Instructors will have their temperature checked/logged and apply hand sanitizer upon entering the building.
- Students will wait in their vehicles or along the sidewalk next to the ENTER sign while maintaining social distancing of at least 6 feet apart.
- Students will be called by an instructor and enter through the second lobby entrance and the door will remain open.
- An instructor will take each student's temperature with a no-touch thermometer and it will be logged in the role book.
 - If temperature is > than 100°F, the individual must go home, monitor, and contact PCP.
- Each student will apply hand sanitizer during their entrance screening.
- ★ We are working on having virtual options via Zoom for certain classes.



★ Entering the Building Continued...

- To limit exposure risk, loitering in the lobby is not permitted.
- We politely ask parents/guardians and/or siblings to stay in their vehicles or return to the studio for pick up at the end of class.
- However, if the student is 6 years old or younger, they may be accompanied into the building by one parent or guardian.
- Masks are required at all times while in the building.
- We asking anyone to stay at home if they have been experiencing:
 - Fever greater or equal to 100°F.
 - Cough that is new, different or more severe than season allergies.
 - New or worsening loss of smell or taste.
 - In the last 72 hours, have had contact
 (unmasked less than 6 feet for 10 min or more)
 with anyone who is waiting for COVID-19 test
 results or who has a confirmed positive
 COVID-19 test.

★ Entering and using the studio:

- Students will go straight to their assigned studio.
- Students will need to stagger their belongings at least 6 feet apart by utilizing the markings along the walls.
 - If Studio C is unoccupied, please place your belongings in there.
- In the main lobby there will soon be lonopure
 Sanitizer diffusing through a Homech Cool Mist
 Diffuser during our hours of operation.


STUDENT ENTRANCE ONLY

★ During active class time:

- Social distancing:
 - Dancers should maintain a distance of at least 6
 feet apart, but preferably 10 feet apart if possible,
 as there is some research showing that the
 breath from exercise can carry the virus greater
 distances.
 - Activities that would require direct or indirect contact, such as partnering, or any movements involving touching the face, will be restricted until further notice.
- Masks are required at all times while inside the building.
- The water fountain will be closed. Please bring your own water bottle or drink. You may remove your mask during water breaks, but please ensure you maintain a safe distance of at least 6 feet apart.
- Students are free to use the restrooms at any time, but we ask the restroom only be occupied by one person at a time.

★ During active class time continued...

- Floor work: there will be tape markings on the floor spaced 6-10 feet apart.
- Across the floor: there will be tape markings on the baseboard/walls spaced 6 feet apart to utilize while waiting your turn. Students will go across the floor one at a time and must wait to begin their turn only after the student before them has completely moved to the other end.
- Barre: The only group equipment that will be utilized during this time will be the ballet barres.
 Students and barres will be spaced out appropriately.



★ Exiting the building:

- Students will exit through the main front door.
- There will be hand sanitizer in the lobby for easy access while exiting.
- We will aim to hold the door open or have the door propped open to prevent any extra contact with high-touch surfaces.
- Students that do not yet drive may wait to be picked up in the main lobby. Chairs will be spaced out to maintain social distancing.
- One parent/guardian of students 6 years or younger may enter the main lobby area at the time of class dismal for pick-up.



★ Measures between classes:

- There will be a delay of at least 5 minutes between classes to allow for:
 - Cleaning between classes.
 - Time to conduct entrance screenings with temperature checks.
 - Avoid exiting & entering simultaneously.
- What will be cleaned between classes?
 - All high-touch surfaces such as:
 - Doors/handles
 - Ballet barres (if used)
 - Stereos and instructor's phone
 - Floors
 - Bathroom door handles
 - Toilet handles
 - Sink handles

★ Cleaning Specifics:

- Hand sanitizers in each room.
- Antibacterial soap in bathrooms.
- Hygienic paper towel dispenser in the bathrooms.
